The Enrichment Center in Nashua, NH seeks a seasonal summer art instructor for our art specialty day camp. We seek a detail-oriented, organized, curious self-starter who loves to learn, improve and expand their skills; and wants to share their enthusiasm for art and creativity with others. This person must be dependable and thrive in a flexible environment. Additionally, the instructor must believe in the importance of providing multi-disciplinary education that encourages students to learn and think in different ways.

We are seeking someone who can teach one whole week (i.e., one camp) or a few weeks (i.e., 2-10), depending on your availability.

Our Painted Turtle Art Summer Camp is a day camp that runs over a ten-week period and offers weekly programs for kids 6-14 years of age. Campers sign up for a week-long camp and each week offers a different focus. Some examples from past camps include:

- Art Exploration Through the Ages
- Illustrate It!: Painting, Drawing, and Animation
- Mask Making and Sculpture Design
- 3A's Literary Arts, Art and Theater Arts

If you wish you had these camps when you were growing up, and you want to share your skills in Minecraft or a software programming language, this summer camp teaching opportunity may be for you.

The work schedules, which includes class preparation, instruction, and clean up, are as follows:

- 5 days of orientation/planning meetings (paid)
- Summer work hours are approximately 8-4:30pm five days per week.
- Preparation is 8:00am to 8:45 am.
- Campers are dropped off at 8:45am and picked up at 4pm.
- Clean up is 4:00pm - 4:30 pm; although campers are expected to help with majority of clean up prior to pick up.

Job description/responsibilities:

- Class planning and preparation
- Write lesson plan for the camp week
- Create a positive, achievement-oriented learning environment
- Monitor and ensure the safety of students and materials
- Set up class space, clean room after class, and store materials properly. These activities include, but are not limited to the following:
 - Organizing materials
 - Cleaning any surfaces compromised by art media

- Sweeping of floors, proper disposal of materials scraps, returning equipment to proper storage
- Must ensure proper dismissal sign-in / sign-out sheets to designated staff leader with or without site coordinator present
- Provide quality, thought provoking teaching
- Good citizenship by respecting students and fellow colleagues, offering a helping hand when possible for you, and being trustworthy and honest. Being a team player, and ability to adapt to ever-changing circumstances.

Requirements:

- Minimum of Bachelor's degree (or in degree program)
- Enjoy working with children ages 6-14
- Experience teaching kids ages 6-14 preferred, including summer camp counseling
- Educational or professional background, or demonstrated passion in art and/or STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, and math):
